

Reception Learning Web Spring 2 2019

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

In PSED we will continue to encourage the children to develop their confidence and to try new activities, explaining why they like some activities more than others. Children will continue to develop their confidence when speaking in a familiar group, and will talk about how they and others show feelings. They will continue to learn about how their own and others behaviour has consequences.

Communication and Language

We will continue to develop our speaking, listening and understanding in topic based activities and games and in our phonics sessions.

We will also continue to practise and develop our language skills in songs, text and story telling.

Physical Development

This half term children will be developing their control and co-ordination with large and small movements. They will be learning to move confidently in a range of ways, safely negotiating space.

Children will continue to develop their skill in handling equipment and tools effectively, including pencils for writing.

Children will be learning about the importance of a healthy diet and exercise and will be learning about ways of keeping safe and healthy.

Children will manage their own basic hygiene and personal needs successfully, including dressing themselves and going to the toilet independently.

Understanding the World

Children will talk about past and present events in their own lives and in the lives of family members. They will learn that other children don't always enjoy the same things, and be sensitive to this. They will learn about similarities and differences between themselves and others, and among families, communities and traditions.

Maths

Children will continue to learn to count reliably with numbers from 1 to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects, they will be learning to add and subtract two single digit numbers and count on or back along the number line to find the answer. They will be learning to solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

Expressive Arts and Design

This half term children will be exploring ways of changing sounds, singing songs, making music and dancing.

They will be learning to safely use a range of tools and techniques and experimenting with colour, design, and texture.

Literacy

This half term, children will continue to develop their skills in reading and understanding simple sentences. They will continue to practise using their phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately.

Children will also continue to learn some common irregular or 'tricky' words which cannot be sounded out (for example 'was').

Children will continue to learn to demonstrate their understanding of what they have read through talking to others.

In writing, children will continue to learn to use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds. They will also be learning to spell some 'tricky' words correctly in their writing. Children will be learning to write sentences which can be read by themselves and others.
